Parish Finances: The best way for Church contribution in St. Mary's Church is by Standing Order, Direct Debit and Contactless Machine.

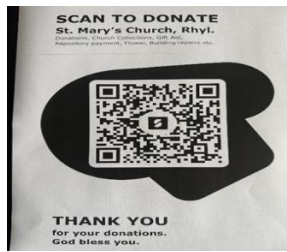
